Language requirements	<p>Students wishing to follow English taught lectures should possess a B2 level.</p> <p>Students wishing to follow German taught lectures should possess a B2 level.</p>
Intensive German language course	<p>THU is offering a pre-semester intensive German course of 2 weeks which is offered for students with absolutely no or only little knowledge in German.</p> <p>Dates: first two weeks of March (only for ICEP/IEEP students) two weeks in mid September.</p>
German language course (during the semester)	<p>Throughout the semester all students have to attend a German language class which is offered on different levels.</p>

Application procedure for students	<p>Students should be nominated by their home universities first. We will then send them the link to our online application form. Students should be able to follow lectures in English or German (level B2).</p>

Application deadlines	<p>1st of May for the following fall semester 1st of November for the following spring semester</p> <p>Please note: the online application will be closed at May 1st and November 1st. It will not be possible to apply after this date.</p>
Course selection	All students are asked to sign up for a minimum of 20 ECTS.

Costs	
Living expenses	For living expenses, students should calculate a minimum of € 1000,--/month. Students from Non-European countries who have to apply for a residence permit in Germany will have to prove financial means of €934/month.
Registration Fee	Every student has to pay a registration fee of approx. €80 to the association of student affairs to get the student ID card.
Health insurance	All Non-European students must sign for a German insurance policy (costs: around €140 per month).

Housing	
Accommodation / Housing	THU will try to provide housing in a student dormitory for exchange students considering the wishes, mentioned in the housing request form. However, the situation in Ulm has become very difficult and we can not guarantee to find housing for all students. Housing prices range in the dormitory is approx. €400-500 per month (security deposit of €600) per room.
