Application	
Application procedure for students	<u>Students should be nominated by their home universities first.</u> We will then send them the link to our online application form. Students should be able to follow lectures in English or German (level B2). The university international coordinator should send the nomination list to Stephanie.wagner@thu.de . <u>Nomination dates:</u> 25 th March for the following fall semester 25 th September for the following spring semester
Application deadlines	1 st of May for the following fall semester 1 st of November for the following spring semester Please note: the online application will be closed at May 1st and November 1st. It will not be possible to apply after this date.

Costs	
Living expenses	For living expenses, students should calculate a minimum of € 1000,-/month. Students from Non-European countries who have to apply for a residence permit in Germany will have to prove financial means of €934/month.
Registration Fee	Every student has to pay a registration fee of approx. €97 to the association of student affairs to get the student ID card.
Health insurance	All Non-European students must sign for a German insurance policy (costs: around €130 per month).

Housing	
Accommodation / Housing	THU will try to provide housing in a student dormitory for exchange students considering the wishes, mentioned in the housing request form. However, the situation in Ulm has become very difficult and we can not guarantee to find housing for all students. Housing prices range in the dormitory is approx. €350-450 per month (security deposit of €300) per room.
